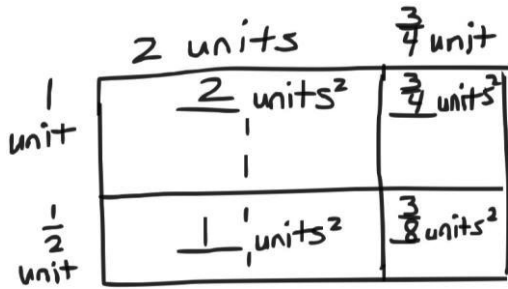

1. Kristen tiled the following rectangles using square units. Sketch the rectangles, and find the areas. Then, confirm the area by multiplying. Rectangle A has been sketched for you.

a. Rectangle A:
